

BINDING HYGIENE AND ANTI-EPIDEMIC CONDITIONS FOR SIGNIFICANT SPORTS EVENTS OR COMPETITIONS

Sporting event: 39th KOWAX VALAŠSKÁ RALLY VALMEZ 2021

Held on: 26 – 28th March 2021

Venue: Valašské Meziříčí and TATRA Kopřivnice area

BINDING HYGIENE AND ANTI-EPIDEMIC PROCEDURES:

- The organizer will arrange an entrance gate to the venue with temperature measuring and collecting a self-reporting forms for all persons entering the venue. A person who does not fill in the self-reporting form or has a temperature higher than 37.5 degrees Celsius, will be allowed to enter only with the consent of a doctor authorized by the organizer.
- There is an obligation for all persons present at the time of the sporting event on the premises of this event to confirm the absence of clinical signs of infectious disease through a self-reporting form (see Attachment). This form will be available for medical inspection by a public health authority in the case of competitors and the implementation team, or by a person authorized by the organizer in the case of other persons present on the premises of the sporting event.
- COVID-19 coordinator: p. Procházka
- Place with possibility of proceeding the antigen test: in specially built tent in area "POLYGON KOPŘIVNICE" with distance approx 200m from SERVICE AREA
- All drivers, team members, officials and members of the organization team (hereinafter referred to as the "obligated person") are required to undergo an RT-PCR test for the presence of SARS-CoV-2 virus before start of the competition. This condition does not apply to obligated persons who have demonstrably suffered from COVID-19, do not have clinical signs of COVID-19, have completed, in accordance with the applicable emergency procedures of the Ministry of Health, isolation due to a positive result of the RT-PCR test and no more than 90 days have elapsed since the first positive result of the RT-PCR test.
- If the obligated person who underwent the examination of the SARS-CoV-2 virus by RT-PCR test is positive and it is a person who has demonstrably suffered from COVID-19 and under the current emergency measures of the Ministry of Health stayed in isolation due to a positive PCR test, this person may participate in the sporting event only if no more than 90 days have elapsed since the first positive RT-PCR result and this person has no clinical signs of COVID-19. If more than 90 days have elapsed since the first positive result of the RT-PCR test, the person will not participate in the sporting event and will be isolated until the decision of the locally competent public health authority on further action.
- In the case of drivers, team members and members of the organization team, or the person authorized by the organizer in the case of other obligated persons, the doctor will mark in the self-reporting form (see Attachment) the date of execution and the result of the last RT-PCR test for the presence of SARS-CoV-2 virus.
- The organizer will ensure check of respirators wearing in the area of the sporting event. This obligation does not apply to the crew inside the car during special stages.
- A respirators of at least class FFP2 or KN95 will be used to protect the air passages. The organizer will only check their application.
- The organizer will ensure the absence of spectators in the area of the race for the duration of the whole sporting event.
- The organizer will ensure that the maximum number of all present at the venue of the sporting event does not exceed 750 people, and movement between individual sectors will be allowed only in necessary cases.

- The organizer will provide adequate space and conditions for the possible need for preliminary isolation in case of suspected infectious respiratory disease – in isolated area near SERVICE AREA
- Transport, accommodation and meals will be provided separately in compliance with applicable measures.
- The organizer will arrange a communication with the locally competent public health authority.
- The organization of this sports event will take place in accordance with the above-mentioned binding hygienic and anti-epidemic conditions, rules for holding sports competitions during the pandemic of the COVID-19 disease issued by the National Sports Agency.

OTHER PROCEDURES:

1. Dividing of the participants of the company leading to the exclusion of contact of individual groups

Dividing of participants into groups in order to eliminate common contacts.

Timekeepers - start and finish of SS, outdoor space, alone

Scrutineers and Technical Delegates - scrutineering, outdoor space, alone

Rally Control - headquarters, closed space

Inspection vehicle crews, safety cars and vehicle drivers - crews will reduce as many contacts at the SS as possible (as much as possible time staying in the car), leaving the vehicle only in necessary cases.

2. Restrictions on movement due to government or regional authority regulations

In case of restrictions on movement, all delegated officials will receive an official Approval from the organizer allowing them to travel to the venue.

3. Testing

On arrival to the venue, event participants will present a PCR test not older than 48 hours. All participants will sign a Covid-19 declaration according to the FIA.

4. Organization of main activities

CONDITIONS:

- All participants present a PCR test not older than 48 hours on arrival

- All participants sign the Covid-19 declaration according to the FIA.

- Temperature measurement

- Inspection of respirators wearing and airway protection

- Hand disinfection before entering the buildings and areas related to the event

a) Headquarters

Isolated area, at the entrance checked by the City Police, number of persons 30, sufficient spacing - see Attachment.

b) Presence of crews, collection of road books and other materials

Isolated area, control at the entrance, limited number of persons - see Conditions.

Everything will be arranged contactless.

c) Administrative checks

Isolated area, control at the entrance, limited number of persons - see Conditions.

Everything will be arranged contactless. In order to minimize physical contacts, crews will be recommended to perform the administrative checks during their presence - see Conditions.

d) Scrutineering

Isolated area, control at the entrance, limited number of persons - see Conditions. We are considering the possibility of scrutineering performed by the delegates as tour around the service area (if it will be possible, it will be specified in a Bulletin).

e) Service area - service parking lot, grouping, closed parking lot Regulated area, check at the entrance - see Conditions. Spacing between people in service: 2meters.

Mechanics on arrival at the service area:

- identification (personal ID, driving license or a passport) so that they can be matched with the list submitted to the Organizers by the Competitor (number of team members may be additionally reduced by a Bulletin)

- submit the filled "Declaration of COVID-19" for mechanics

- receive hand straps in a specified color, which must be carried on their hands throughout the event

5. Official notice board

a) Only an electronic notice board will be used.

b) All documents (Bulletins, Stewards' or CoC's Decisions and other information) will be issued exclusively in electronic form without any confirmation of the document by the crew's signature.

c) The summons of the crew by the Clerk of the Course will be performed in the form of a telephone call.

d) Stewards will decide on the method of summoning the crew at their discretion.

6. Safety and organization vehicles

Crews of safety and control vehicles are requested to limit the contacts on the SS as much as possible (as much as possible staying in the car) - see Conditions.

7. Start and finish ceremony

a) There will be no ceremonies and press conferences during the race.

b) Start of the rally will take place in TC0 at the exit from the service park.

c) Finish of the rally is at the entrance to the Parc Fermé. The prize-giving ceremony will not be organized.

8. Refund of entry fee

In case when a crew member becomes ill with a COVID-19 or quarantine arrangements are ordered, which does not allow the crew to start the rally after the deposit has been paid, the crew will be refunded the full deposit within 14 days from the finish of the rally.

9. Measures in case of capture of COVID-19 at the time of the event

In case of a positive PCR test, participant will be denied to access the venue, his possible contacts will be traced and checked the next or following day (symptoms, temperature, antigen test). Affected person will be sent back to his place of living. All participants who discover COVID-19 symptoms flags during the event will contact the COVID-19 coordinator. The Chief medical will manage following actions.
